


FEDERATED EDGE SOLUTION & BUSINESS MODEL

The products and services available as part of the Federated Edge (FE) are similar to AWS Cloud (i.e. EC2, EBS, VPCs, S3) and will consist of Zadara's Edge Cloud Services solution, including zCompute and zStorage. These products will have competitive pricing to AWS (both in value and use of a consumption based, per hour model) and will be similarly discounted based on contract length. If the Customer agrees to a 12-month term, they will be eligible for up to a 20% discount off of the list price. If the Customer commits to a 36-month term, they will be eligible for up to 50% off list.

The below image depicts an example of the Federated Edge business flow. In this example, one Customer inquires about Federated Edge services directly with their local MSP (a 'Solution Provider' in the FE network). The Solution Provider then assumes responsibility for completing the transaction and provisioning services for the Customer using the FE marketplace. This specific example highlights a Customer that requires FE services across 3 global FE Zones. The Solution Provider will then leverage the FE marketplace to deploy services to 3 unique Operators who are responsible for maintaining FE Zones in each of their respective regions (note: it is possible for a Solution Provider to also be an Operator). It is our mission to offer fully-automated, end-to-end deployment capabilities via the selfserve FE Program marketplace.

The Federate Edge model is a revenue-share-based model where revenues generated by Federated Edge customers are shared by *all* parties responsible for selling (Solution Providers), provisioning (Zadara) and delivering (Operators) Federated Edge compute & storage services. FEDERATED EDGE OPERATOR REQUIREMENTS

The Federated Edge provides a best-in-class, consistent user experience for our global customer base. To ensure consistent service is delivered, Zadara will define minimum capabilities and SLAs that are required to be met by participating Operators. Among these requirements, approved Operators must commit a minimum of one (1) rack dedicated to Zadara equipment, in a Tier III data center that includes:

- ✓ Multiple independent bandwidth paths
- ✓ Redundant power feeds
- ✓ N+1 power plant configuration
- ✓ 24 x 7 x 365 on-site security, monitoring, customer support
- ✓ Service level guarantees at or exceeding 99.98%
